

DRAWING REQUIREMENTS FOR MARINE FURNITURE

A composite drawing of each furniture item submitted for inclusion in the U.S. Navy Shipboard Furniture Catalog shall be prepared by the supplier for approval of the design by Carderock Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center, Habitability Section (Code 9740), Philadelphia, PA 19112-1403.

This drawing shall be generally similar to the type drawing referenced for Navy type items. Type drawings are Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) drawings illustrating general arrangement and details of equipment, systems, or components.

The drawing shall show all dimensions, gages, methods of assembly, and materials specification. Drawings shall be to standard architectural scale. Shop drawings are not acceptable. Details of attachment to structure are required.

The format for the supplier's drawing may follow standard commercial practice, shall be legible, complete with list of material, and be acceptable to CD-NSWC.

Where the supplier's item is one of a group of similar items of similar detail construction, a single drawing, or set of drawings, will suffice for the group, provided that enough information is shown to reflect detail construction of all items in that group.

Similarly, where items, or groups of items are similar to other items or groups of items, except for configuration differences, and all other details apply, a single drawing or set of drawings will suffice which clearly shows all configurations.

After the supplier's drawing for an item has been approved, it will not require further approval unless an alteration is made.
